# Summer Camps at NYS Worksite Child Care Centers

**May 19, 2016**

Worksite child care centers are hosted by numerous state agencies across New York to provide convenient, quality care at affordable rates for children of state employees. Many of the worksite centers offer summer camps for children ages 5-12. All of the worksite summer camps are conveniently located within, or in close proximity to the child care centers at various state sites.

As a result of the collective bargaining agreements, certain state employees are eligible for an Employer Contribution when they enroll in the Dependent Care Advantage Account (DCAAccount). This employer contribution is an important benefit that helps state employees with expenses for child care, elder care, or care for a disabled dependent. The DCAAccount also saves state employees money by allowing them to set aside up to \$5,000 per household in pre-tax salary to pay for dependent care expenses. If you missed the annual fall open enrollment period, you may still be eligible to join.
